


The Artwork

Wall art is the finishing touch in any home. Why settle for yawn-worthy prints from the home store, when you could adorn your walls with your favorite four-legged family member?!

The first step to booking your session is to schedule our session consultation. This phone or zoom call is where we customize your experience to create the magical results that you're after! You'll tell me ALL about your dog and their personality so I can design the perfect session for both of you. I'll answer all your questions and we'll finalize the details of the session—where we're shooting, meeting times, and which products you're most interested in creating.

Don't worry if you don't yet know what you'd like to do with your images—that's what I'm here for! We'll work together to ensure that you're delighted with the final results.

Please note that digital files are NOT included with your session. Although I do offer digital files for sale, I want you to have real products that you'll enjoy every day instead of files languishing on your hard drive.



Yippee! It's time to play! The session is strictly a stress-free time. Your furry family will set the pace, and we'll take plenty of breaks as we explore the area. Don't be concerned if your dog doesn't want to sit, or if he's more interested in the sights and smells than the camera. I promise that even if it feels like your pets aren't listening, or if we need to set up a certain shot multiple times, it's totally fine. I expect it! Your job is to relax and trust that we're creating incredible images—because we are!



About a week after our session, we'll meet online or in your home to view all of the images, choose your favorites, eat some chocolate (an important part of the process), and finalize your order together. Your files will then move into production, where they'll be transformed into gorgeous custom artwork that you'll love for a lifetime.

My dog won't sit still

It's okay! I promise you that I successfully photograph hyper, untrained dogs ALL the time. I guarantee that we'll be able to create images that you love—or I'll refund your reservation fee.

Here's a secret: Most of the dogs you see on my website were wearing leashes during our session.

After some delicate Photoshop work...presto chango...suddenly you see before you a naked dog!

We can even use a special long line to safely create action shots if your dog can't be off leash. And with my arsenal of duck calls and squeakers, I know how to get your pup's attention. You let me know what kind of images you love, and I'll bring the tools and the know-how to create them for you!

Photoshop Magic

Leashes: all the cool kids are wearing them! Your dog's safety is of the utmost importance. In an urban environment, or even out in the wild if your pup is a "flight risk," we'll definitely want to use a leash. But no worries—as you can see from the Before and After images below, it'll stay our little secret thanks to the magic of Photoshop!




Tips for a great session

- ~ Bring some small yummy treats. I will have a selection with me, but if your dog has favorites or a sensitive tummy make sure to bring some along.
- ~ A simple, flat collar (preferable without a LOT of dangling tags) photographs best. If you need a harness or special collar to walk your dog, no worries, just bring a flat collar for the photographs.
- ~Exercise your dog a little before the session, so he/she will be a bit tired.
- ~Brush up on your dog's sit/down/stay prior to their session. But don't worry if they're too excited to hold still on session day:-). I fully expect dogs to move around and need to be re-set MANY times during our session. I also capture lots of candid images where your dog is just being a dog.
- ~My dog can't be off-leash, what now. Not a big deal, most sessions take place entirely on leash and they're edited out later.





~Most importantly, RELAX and ENJOY the experience. Dog's sense our stress, so if you're relaxed and having fun your dog will too. As long as your dog is happy and having fun we'll get great images.
